### Swimming Gala on Friday 27/02

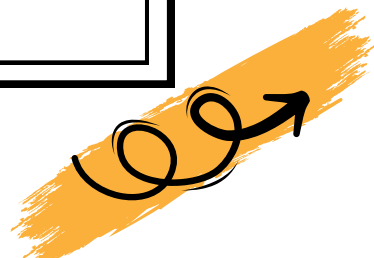
The **A team** swam at **King David**. They came **1<sup>st</sup>** against Yehsiva, Crawford and King David.
